CONSTITUTION OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE OF THE CENTRAL
ZONAL COUNCIL - AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION NO. 5/1/83-ZCS(C)
DATED 18TH FEBRUARY, 1983

Whereas Section 15(b) of the States Reorganisation Act, 1956 (Act No.37 of 1956) stands amended to include the new States of Chhattisgarh and Uttaranchal in the Central Zonal Council from the appointed day by virtue of the provisions to this effect contained in Section 77 of the Madhya Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2000 (Act 28 of 2000) and Section 85 of the Uttar Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2000 (Act 29 of 2000) respectively;

And whereas the Standing Committee of the Central Zonal Council, which was earlier reconstituted vide Central Zonal Council Secretariat's Resolution No.5/1/83-ZCS(C) dated 18th February, 1983 in pursuance of the decision taken vide para 2 of the proceedings of the Central Zonal Council meeting held at Bhopal on 17.10.1982 and with the approval of the Chairman Central Zonal Council (Union Home Minister), is required to be further reconstituted to include members from the new member States of the Central Zonal Council, namely - Chhattisgarh and Uttaranchal; and

Now therefore, the Standing Committee of Central Zonal Council is hereby reconstituted as follows:

The Secretary of the Central Zonal Council shall be the Chairman and Convener of the Standing Committee.

The Standing Committee shall consider and undertake in-depth studies in respect of such matters as are referred to it by the Council; provide referral services by taking up issues with the Governments concerned and place the recommendations before the Council.

The Standing Committee may associate the representatives of the Ministry of Finance, other concerned Ministries and the Planning Commission in the context of subjects which are referred to it by the Council whenever necessary.

The Standing Committee shall also be responsible for keeping a watch on the progress of implementation of the Council's recommendations. The Standing Committee may devise its own procedure for effective functioning subject to the Rules of procedure of the Central Zonal Council and the States Reorganisation Act, 1956.
